Indian Public School, Jagadhari was started in year 2004. It was affiliated with CBSE in 2007 upto class XII in all streams. It was established under SH. LACHHMAN DAS EDUCATION SOCIETY, Yamuna Nagar after the name of an illiterate farmer who had love for education and taught all his children up to Graduate level. It was his wish that among his children the most educated Dr. O.P Taneja and his wife Dr. C.K Taneja should establish a school for children of rural farmers so that their children get the facility of Modern Public School Education in English Medium at reasonable cost to fulfill his dream. Dr. Taneja after retiring as principal from Govt. College services in Haryana started establishing this school in 2004. Today after 10 years of its affiliation it has earned its place in some of the well known schools in Yamuna Nagar district. It provides bus facilities to rural students with a fleet of 13 buses with in a radius of 25 KMS. It involves students in various extra co-curricular activities. After establishing necessary infrastructure for transport and academics, the school has started establishing best possible facilities for the sports and cultural activities. Under the guidance of managing committee, the institution is aiming to become one of the best known schools not only in Yamuna Nagar but also in the state.

This school was established in the year 2004. It is a Public/Private school working on the basic aim of providing affordable quality education to all the future citizens and our proud country. Ours is an organization dedicated to creating awareness of our rich culture, proud history and world community. Our focus is on strengthening moral values to help the child build a good character, positive attitude and strong spiritual life.
